

## **Weekly Market Review**



#### **Economic & Market Developments**

- The NAHB Housing Market Index, which measures home builder confidence, came in at new all time highs of 85 in September, better than then market expectations at 83.
- Housing Starts for September were 1.415 million, just under expectations of 1.457 million, but was 1.9% higher than August.
- Building Permits saw monthly growth of 5.2% in September, coming in at 1.553 million, the most since March 2007.
- Existing Home sales grew 9.4% in September, well above expectations of 5%.
- Mortage rates continued to decline last week, with the 30 year printing a record low of 2.80%.


